

Subject: Assignment of Irrevocable Deregistration and Export Request Authorizations (IDERAs)

To: All AFS-750 Conveyance Examiners, Exam Supervisors & Program Analysts

Background. On March 1, 2006, the Registry began accepting Irrevocable Deregistration and Export Request Authorizations (IDERAs) in relation to security instruments filed against Cape Town eligible aircraft. The Aircraft Registration Branch has recently received documents seeking to assign IDERAs in conjunction with the assignment of the security agreements to which they relate.

Information: The Technical Section Staff, in consultation with Aeronautical Center Counsel, has determined that the assignment of a security agreement renders ineffective, for Registry purposes, any IDERA linked to that agreement. If an IDERA is desired by the assignee(s) of a security agreement, the registered owner of the aircraft should execute a new IDERA identifying the assignee as the authorized party.
