## BIOGRAPHY

Dan Loeffler focuses his practice on complex commercial litigation. In 2008, he returned home to Oklahoma to serve as vice president and general counsel of a privately held company in Oklahoma City. He joined McAfee & Taft in January 2010.

### Antitrust Litigation and Counseling:
